

## Alupe University Champions Responsible Living During World Condom Day 2026



Alupe University marked this year's World Condom Day with a vibrant and impactful awareness campaign held on 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> February 2026, aimed at promoting responsible sexual behaviour and safeguarding the health and future of its students.

Through strategic partnerships with the Ministry of Health Kenya, the Trust for Indigenous Culture and Health (TICAH), and the Office of the Students' Counselor, the University amplified a clarion call encouraging students and the wider university community to embrace protected sexual practices.

The two-day campaign provided an engaging platform for awareness creation on sexual behaviour, peer-to-peer learning, and, most importantly, the demystification of persistent misconceptions surrounding condom use among students.
