**SUBJECT: REGULATION OF CAMPAIGN PERIOD AND CONDUCT DURING STUDENT
CAMPAIGNS**

The Office of the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic, Research and Student Affairs) has noted with concern incidents of verbal and physical violence during the ongoing student leadership campaign, particularly at night. Such conduct is unacceptable and contravenes the University's rules and regulations, which require all students to uphold discipline, respect, and peaceful engagement.

To maintain peace, order, and a conducive learning environment, the University hereby directs as follows:


- 1. Campaign Time:**
All campaign activities shall strictly be conducted between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- 2. Prohibition of Violence:**
Any form of violence, intimidation, harassment, or abusive language during campaigns is strictly prohibited.
- 3. Disciplinary Action:**
Any student found participating in acts of violence will be subjected to disciplinary action in accordance with the University's rules and regulations.
- 4. Candidate Accountability:**
In accordance with the AUSO Constitution, any aspirant whose supporters engage in acts of violence or misconduct during the campaign period risks disqualification from the election process.

All students and aspirants are therefore urged to conduct their campaigns peacefully, responsibly, and in a manner that upholds the dignity and values of Alupe University.

The University expects full cooperation from all students to ensure that the campaign period remains orderly, respectful, and free of violence.
