STUDENT DRESS CODE ON UNIVERSITY PREMISES AND OFFICIAL UNIVERSITY FUNCTIONS

According to Alupe University rules and regulations governing the conduct and discipline of students' article 3.2 c, e and 9.1 xiv; Students should wear acceptable and decent attire while on campus and/or official University functions to promote modesty and professionalism. However, we have observed and noted with concern the indecent dressing and non-adherence to mentioned articles by some students. The following are not acceptable dress code for Alupe University.

1. Female students should NOT wear:

- Micro/mini-skirts
- Dresses/skirts with slits extending above the thigh
- Dresses/blouses with open/revealing necklines
- Body-hugging/skin tight trousers, and biker pants
- Dresses that stretch e.g., spandex, body cones,
- Micro shorts
- Crop tops, capped sleeves and sleeveless tops/vests,
- Dirty, torn, ragged, tripped jeans that reveal parts of the body, indecent jeans
- Bare-backs attires or those that reveal bra straps
- Navel-gazers, commonly known as "tumbo-cuts"
- See-throughs/transparent, or revealing clothes

1. Male students should NOT wear:

- Hats/caps in class, chapel, offices and at University functions
- Headscarves
- Clothes that expose the chest and/or tattoos on any part of the body
- Torn, ragged or ripped jeans
- Plaiting and dread locks

Both MALE and FEMALE students should observe the following:

- No casual footwear e.g. crocs, slippers, other plastic sandals etc.
- No exposed tattoos and wordings on any part of the body
- Modest use and application of make up
- No wearing of "shades" (sun glasses) in class, chapel and offices
- Shirts, T-Shirts and trousers with obscene wordings, graphics and/or expressions
- Hairstyles should be neat and clean. The following are not allowed:
 - Hairstyles in excessively bright and peculiar colors e.g. yellow, blue, red and white
 - Unkempt Dreadlocks

NB: Failure to observe Alupe University dress code shall lead to sanctions which may include:

- a. Denial of entry into the University or any official function of the University.
- b. Denial of services in the University offices.
- c. Eviction from classroom or examination room or any other office.
- d. Non-refusal to comply may lead to disciplinary action in accordance Alupe University rules and regulations governing the conduct and discipline of students

Any eviction from the classroom/examination room shall be treated as absence.
